COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Fifty
Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) as damages for that on, heretofore, towit: the 14th day of June, 1958, at about 2:00 oclock A. M. at a
point approximately four (4) miles South of Bay Minette, Baldwin County,
Alabama, on U. S. Highway #31, a public highway in said County, the
Defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle as to cause or allow the same to run into, upon and against an automobile being then
and there operated by the said Joseph H. Hamilton and as a proximate
consequence and result of the negligence of the Defendant, aforesaid,
the said Joseph H. Hamilton sustained serious permanent personal injuries in this: Three vertebra in his back were broken, he sustain-

ed a cut over his right eye requiring eight (8) stitches and leaving a scar about one and one-half inches long, his left knee was cut and bruised, he sustained a cut on his left leg, his left ankle was cut, he suffered internal injuries which caused him to pass blood, he was caused to suffer and continues to suffer great pain and mental anguish and to suffer from numbness in both of his legs, he suffered multiple contusions and abrasions over his entire body and he was made sick, sore and lame and was permanently disabled, he was caused to incur hospital and doctors bills in the treatment of his injuries and will continue to incur medical expenses in the treatment of his injuries and to suffer pain from said injuries; wherefore Plaintiff brings this suit and asks judgment in the above amount.

COUNT TWO:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) as damages for that on, heretofore, towit: June 14, 1958, at about 2:00 o'clock A. M. at a point approximately four (4) miles South of Bay Minette, on U. S. Highway #31, a public road in Baldwin County, Alabama, the Defendant willfully and wantonly injured the Plaintiff by then and there willfully and wantonly driving an automobile into an automobile then and there being operated by the Plaintiff and as a proximate consequence and result of the willfullness and wantoness of the Defendant, aforesaid, the Plaintiff suffered serious personal injuries in this: three vertebra in his back were broken, he sustained a cut over his right eye requiring eight (8) stitches and leaving a scar about one and one-half inches long, his left knee was cut and bruised, he sustained a cut on his left leg, his left ankle was cut, he suffered internal injuries which caused him to pass blood, he was caused to suffer and continues to suffer with numbness in both of his legs, he suffered multiple contusions and abrasions over his entire body and he was made sick, sore and lame and was permanently injured, he was caused to incur hospital and doctors bills and will continue to incur doctors bills and to suffer pain from said injuries, wherefore Plaintiff brings this suit and asks judgment in the above amount.
