## COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff, William James Mair, a minor, who sues by his next friend and father, Alexander Mair, claims of the Defendants the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars as damages for this, to-wit: That on, to-wit, the 10th day of October, 1958, the Plaintiff, who was then a minor of sum sixteen years of age, was on Highway #98, a public throughfare in the City of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama, at or near a point some 150 yards South of Fairwood Boulevard, a place where he had a right to be, and at said time and place, the Defendant, John Edmundson, so negligently drove an automobile owned by the Defendant, Eleanor J. Edmundson, that it was caused to collide with the person of the Plaintiff, William James Mair, and as proximate consequence of such negligence, the Flaintiff was made sick and sore and received a compound fracture of his lower leg, and suffered much pain, all the Plaintiff's damage in the amount aforesaid, hence this suit.
