The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant FOURTEEN HUNDRED TWENTY TWO AND 53/100 DOLLARS (\$1,422.53) balance due on a promissory note made by the Defendant on the 11th day of April, 1956 and payable in twenty-one monthly installments, one installment being due and payable in July, 1959. The Plaintiff avers that the Defendant defaulted in the payment of this installment and all subsequent monthly installments and that the whole balance has become due and payable. The Plaintiff claims interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the 1st day of July, 1956; this being provided for in the terms of said promissory note. The Plaintiffs further aver that the Defendant agreed in said promissory note to pay all expenses including reasonable attorney's fees incurred in collecting the same and the Plaintiff claims a reasonable attorney's fee in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$215.00)
