Hearin and Jessie McMillan Hearin shall not again marry except to ~~each~~ each other until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days ~~they~~ they shall not marry again except to ~~each~~ each other during the pendency of said appeal

It is further ordered and decreed that said defendant Jessie McMillan Hearin may resume her former name Jessie McMillan.

My name is Robert M. Hearin, I am complainant in the cause of Robert M. Hearin against Jessie McMillan Hearin, pending in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, I am the husband of said Jessie McMillan Hearin. We were married at Bay Minette August 1st, 1918, and lived together as husband and wife until March 21st, 1921, on which date she abandoned me voluntarily without cause. We have not lived together as husband and wife since that time. I did not give her any cause to leave me and do not know of any reason for her leaving. We both live in Baldwin County, Alabama. I have lived in Baldwin County continuously for more than three years next preceeding the filing of this case.

Jessie Mc Millan Hearin and myself Robert M Hearing were over the age of 21 years before the Robert M Hearin filing of this bill.

Leita Hill being duly sworn testified as follows:

My name is Alleta Hill. I am the daughter of Jessie McMillan Hearin. My mother and Mr. Robert M. Hearin married at Bay Minette August 1st, 1918 and lived together until March 21st, 1921, when she voluntarily left him and since that time they have not lived together. I do not know of any ~~any reason~~ for her leaving him. I have frequently seen them in the home and he was always kind. Mr. Hearin has lived continuously next preceeding the filing of this case in Baldwin

County, Alabama, for more than three years. Jessie Mc Millan Hearin and Robert M Hearin were Alleta Hill both over the age of 21 years before the filing of this bill.



Comes. Robert M. Hearin, and humbly complaining against

follows:-

FIRST: That said complainant, Robert M. Hearin is
over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of Baldwin
County, Alabama, that he has been for more than three years
next preceeding the filing of this bill continuously a resident
of this State and County; that said defendant, Jessie McMillan
Hearin is over the age of twenty-one years and a resident of
Baldwin County, Alabama.

SECOND: That said defendant and your complainant are
husband and wife having intermarried at Bay Minette, Alabama,
August 1, 1918; that from the said date until March 21st, 1921
