- 1. That there was filed by him a petition in voluntary bankruptcy on the 21st day of July, 1960, in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Alabama. Bankrupt Case No. 13,106, and that the defendant was adjudicated a bankrupt by said court on the 21st day of July, 1960.
