Plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE and 85/100 (\$2,871.85) DOLLARS, balance due from him on a promissory note made by him on the 19th day of April, 1954, in the sum of \$3500.00, to the Bank of Fairhope, payable in monthly installments of \$100.00 each, commencing on the 17th day of May, 1954, which said note was endorsed by plaintiff, the defendant having made default thereon the plaintiff paid the same on September 17, 1955, the same was by the said Bank of Fairhope on said date assigned to the plaintiff, and on which said note there is a balance due the plaintiff the said sum of \$2,871.85, together with interest thereon from December 31, 1958.

Plaintiff further alleges that in and by said note defendant promised to pay all cost of collection, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and plaintiff claims the further and additional sum of \$431.77 as a reasonable attorney's fee in the premises.

Comes the FAIRHOPE ICE & CREAMERY COMPANY, INC., a Corporation, which makes its answer by and through M. O. BERGLIN, its agent duly authorized to make this answer, and for answer to the writ of garnishment served on it in this cause, says:

That it is indebted to said defendant in the sum of

80.00 Eighty Dollars, being the amount due the said defendant for wages, as salary or

compensation, for the personal service of the defendant, who is a resident of the State of Alabama, as a laborer or employee of this garnishee; that it is indebted to said defendant in no other sum, either at the time of the service of this garnishment, or at the time of making this answer, or at any time intervening the time of the service of said garnishment and the time of making this answer; that it will not be indebted to said defendant, except for wages as above stated, in the future by a contract then or now existing; nor will it be liable to the defendant by virtue of a contract then or now existing for the delivery of personal property, or for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property; that it has not in its possession or under its control money or effects belonging to said defendant; that it has no contract with, and is not liable to said defendant in any other manner than as is herein above set forth.

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
