The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants SEVENTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$7500.00) DOLLARS as damages for that heretofore on to-wit, the 5thday of December, 1958, the Defendants, Goff Jerkins, Clarence Miller and Miller &Jerkins, Inc., a corporation, acting by and through their agent, servant or employee, Charles Hudson Raines, who was then and there acting within the line and scope of his employment so negligently operated an automobile truck on or along U. S. Highway No. 90, a public highway, at or near the east end of Blakely Bridge and approximately 6.2 miles east of the City of Mobile and in BaldwinCounty, Alabama; that said automobile truck was negligently driven into or against the automobile of the Plaintiff at said time and place, and as a direct and proximate consequence and result of said negligence the Plaintiff wasinjured as follows: he received whip-lash injuries to his neck; his shoulder joints were bruised and injured; he was caused to suffer much anguish and pain and spend great sums of money in the treatment of his injuries; he has suffered temporary and permanent damages, all to the loss of the Plaintiff in the aforesaid amount.

The Plaintiff avers that the Defendant, Charles Hudson Raines, is and was on the date of said collision a non-resident of theState of Alabama; that the present post office address of this said Defendant is Route 3, Bonifay, Florida; that the Defendants, Goff Jerkins, and Clarence Miller and Miller & Jerkins, Inc., a corporation, are and were on the date of said collision non-residents of theState of Alabama, and that their present post office addresses are Bonifay, Florida; and the Plaintiff prays that service of process upon the Defendants, Charles Hudson Raines, Goff Jerkins, Clarence Willer and Miller &Jerkins, Inc., a corporation, be had in accordance with the provisions of the Code of Alabama of 1940, Title 7, Section 199.
