That on the 8th day of September, 1958, at the city of Foley, Alabama, the Defendant made and delivered to the Farmers & Merchants Bank for value, his promissory note in writing dated the 8th day of September, 1958, wherein he promised, for value received, to pay on the 10th day of November, 1958 to the Farmers & Merchants Bank, the sum of EIGHTEEN HUNDRED SIXTY SIX and 40/100 (\$1866.40) DOLLARS with interest thereon from date of maturity at 8% per annum, payable at the Farmers & Merchants Bank, Foley, Alabama. That no part of the note has been paid by the Defendant except the sum of \$65.00 credited on account of the principal thereof. On the 14th day of July, 1958, said Farmers & Merchants Bank did duly assign and transfer unto the Plaintiff the said note. The Plaintiff is now the owner and holder of said note, which is now due and unpaid, with the interest thereon as aforesaid.

And the Plaintiff alleges that the Defendant in said note and as part of the consideration thereof did as to this debt waive his rights of exemption as to personal property granted under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, and agreed to pay a reasonable fee for the attorney for the collection thereof, which the Plaintiff further claims in the sum of TWO HUNDRED SEVENTY (\$270.00) DOLLARS, together with the interest on both amounts.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY SEVEN and 03/100 (\$387.03) DOLLARS, due from him by account on the 9th day of September, 1958, which sum of money with the interest thereon is still unpaid.
