That Gustav Schuman, Jr. is over the age of twenty-one (21) years and resides in Chicago, Ill.

2. That your petitioners, Anna Fesel and Gustav Schuman, Jr. are joint owners of the following described real-estate, located in Baldwin County, Ala., to-wit:

lots Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18) and the West Half of Lot Nineteen (W $\frac{1}{2}$ 19) in Block Seven (7) of Perdido Beach, being a subdivision of parts of Sections Eighteen (18) and Nineteen (19), Township Eight (8) South, Range Six (6) East of St. Stephen's Meridian, situated in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, as recorded on December 23, 1925, in Map Book 1, Pages 63-64.
