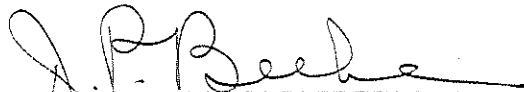

11. Please state the balance owing by you to them on account of the said purchase.

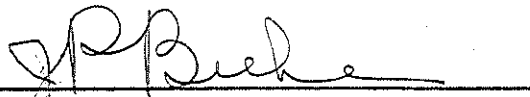
