Did they separate and if so when or about when? State any facts known to you with reference-to the treatment of Katie Burrell by William A Burrell during the time you knew them as living together as man and wife. State if watie Burrel left or abandoned William A Burrell without just cause or legal excuse and when or about when .

Int. 2. If you state that Katie Burrell abandoned William A Burrell while they were living together near Hopewell in Cleburne county the later part of the year 1915 or in February 1916, state where she went to after she abandoned him; if you state that during the year 1914 that William A Burrell and Katie Burrell moved to cleburen county near Hopewell to live, state in how long or about how long they lived together backers man and wife.
