
TO THE HONORABLE H. M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF
BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA:

Your Petitioner, James R. Owen, on behalf of John R. Rice, respectfully shows unto the Court and your Honor as follows:

1. That the said John R. Rice is now illegally restrained of his liberty and is imprisoned in the County Jail of Baldwin County, Alabama, at Bay Minette, Alabama, by Taylor Wilkins, the Sheriff of said County. The said Taylor Wilkins, as Sheriff of said County, restrains the said John R. Rice under a warrant issued on or about December 2, 1959; petitioner avers that he believes the said warrant to be in existence charging the said John R. Rice with the crime of assault to murder, although he has not seen the said warrant; and further, that the said Taylor Wilkins, as Sheriff of Baldwin County, restrains the said John R. Rice under a commitment issued by the Honorable W. R. Stuart, who held a preliminary hearing for the said John R. Rice on December 7, 1959, and bound the said John R. Rice to the Grand Jury and affixed his bond at \$2500.00 which bond petitioner alleges to be excessive.

2. Your petitioner respectfully shows unto your Honor that the said John R. Rice is illegally restrained of his liberty because the bond which the Honorable W. R. Stuart affixed as aforesaid, is illegal and unlawful because it is excessive.

3. Your Petitioner further shows that by reason of the said excessive bond being unlawful and illegal, the said John R. Rice is being illegally restrained of his liberty, that he is being illegally imprisoned and that his said detention is unlawful.
