following described property, to wit:

Potatoes; fifty bushels of Corn

which said writ was on the 10 day of Febry 1916, placed in the hands
of C. E. Eubanks Sheriff of said County, for due execution thereof, and
which said writ said C. E. Eubanks Sheriff as aforesaid, executed according
to its mandates, by taking possession of the following property, to wit:

About Seven hundred bushels of Sweet
Potatoes

and whereas the said J. R. Nelson Defendant in said
suit, has failed and neglected for the space of five days from the taking into possession of said property by

said 66 Encumbrances Sheriff as aforesaid, to give bond and take possession of said property as authorized by law:

Now, if the said Peoples Fertilizer Company Plaintiff in said suit, shall deliver the above described property to the said J R Nelson Defendant in said suit, within thirty days after judgment, together with damages for the detention of property and cost of suit, in case he shall fail to recover the same in this suit, then and in that event this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

And we and each of us hereby waive all rights of claim of exemption as the personal property we or either of us have now, or may hereafter have under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama, and we hereby severally certify that we have property free from all encumbrance to the full amount of the above bond.
