the age of twenty one years; Willie Lee Britt is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, where she has lived all of her

life; she was a bona fide resident of this county and state for more

than one year next immediately preceeding the filing of her bill

for divorce which was filed in August, 1922; Willie Lee Britt and

Wallace Earl Britt are both over twenty one years of age; Wallace

Earl Britt is a non-resident of the state of Alabama; when I last

heard of him he was in Italy but just what place I do not know and

could not find out.

They were married in September, 1918 and they lived to-gether as man and wife until in April, 1921. While they were living together I went to visit them on different occasions; About April, 1921, while I was visiting them Wallace Britt committed actual violence on Willie Lee Britt; striking her; I was at the house at the time and I also examined the scars afterwards; his conduct was such that there was reason to fear more acts of actual violence on Willie Lee Britt with danger to her life or health. At a later date she somplained to me that he had choked her; they never lived together after that time, she living with me and my husband, her father, at Point Clear in this county where she lives now and has lived continuously since they separated in April, 1921.

I know of no cause he had for treating her as he did; she has never lived with him since these acts were committed.
