

Spring Term, 1916.

1. The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), due from him by account on the 1st day of November, 1915.
2. The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), due from him by account on the 1st day of December, 1915.
3. The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), due from by account on the 1st day of December, 1915.
4. The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), damages for the breach of an agreement entered into by him on the 1st day of March, 1915, by which, he inconsideration of a lease to him of the turpentine rights on Sections 13 & 14, Township 2 South of Range 3 East, Baldwin County, Alabama, agreed to pay the plaintiff the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in September or October, 1915, provided the market price of turpentine reached 45 ¢ per gallon during the season of 1915; and the further sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in October or November, 1915, provided the market price of turpentine reached 50 ¢ per gallon during the season of 1915. And the plaintiff avers that the market price of turpentine reached both the above mentioned figures, 45 ¢ & 50 ¢ per gallon, during the season of 1915. And the defendant, although often requested to do so, has failed and refused, and continues to fail and refuse, to pay the said sum agreed upon to be paid upon the happening of the aforesaid event.

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), damages for the breach of an agreement entered into by him on the 1st day of March, 1915, in words and figures as follows:

"Memorandum of agreement made and entered into between John M. Green, party of the first part, and S. J. Whitley, party of the second part, Witnesseth: That party of the first part agrees to re-lease his timber for turpentine purposes on Sections 13 & 14 in Township 2 South, Range 3 East, Baldwin County, Alabama, for the year 1915. The same having been worked the past three years by party of the second part. Consideration as follows, to wit: One Hundred Dollars cash in hand paid by party of the second part, and deferred payments as follows: Three drafts, bearing even date, herewith, each for One Hundred Dollars and payable respectfully, June 1st, July 1st and August 1st, 1915, Said drafts to bear 6 % interest from date until paid. Said interest to be added to the amount of 100, which shows on each draft. In addition to the above Four Hundred dollars, same party of the second part agrees to pay the further sum of two hundred dollars, conditional upon the market price of turpentine during the season of 1915. 100 dollars in September or October, providing the market price reaches 45 ¢ per gal., and 100 dollars in October or November, 1915, providing the market price of turpentine reaches 50 ¢ per gallon during the season of 1915. Witness our hands and seals at bay Minette, Alabama, as of date of March 1st, 1915.

And the plaintiff avers that, although he has complied with all its provisions on his part, and although the market price of turpentine reached the aforesaid figures, viz: 45 ¢ & 50 ¢ per gallon, during the season of 1915, the defendant has failed to comply with the following provision thereof, viz: that he would pay to the plaintiff the following sums of money, to wit: One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in September or October, provided that the market price of turpentine reached 45 ¢ per gallon during the season of 1915; and One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) in October or November, 1915, provided that the market price of turpentine reached 50 ¢ per gallon during the season of 1915.

Which sums of money, with interest thereon, is still due.
