

The Town of Bay Minette by its Attorney, Wm. S. Anderson, charges that the offense of operating a motor vehicle with the muffler thereon cut out, was committed in the Town of Bay Minette by Charles B. Hall, the defendant, within sixty days before the commencement of this prosecution, and in violation of "An Ordinance, to further regulate the operation of Motor Vehicles in the Town of Bay Minette, Ala. approved September 21st 1915" in words and figures as follows:
"Section 1. Be it ordained by the Town Council of Bay Minette, Alabama, that the unnecessary blowing of whistles or horns, or the sounding of gongs, or the unnecessary noise made by the misuse of mufflers or devices intended to prevent detonations or explosions from the motor exhaust is hereby prohibited; and no motor vehicle shall be operated with the muffler thereon cut out.
Section 2. Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after October 5th 1915; and any person, firm, association or corporation, violating any of the provisions thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less than one nor more than one hundred dollars."


