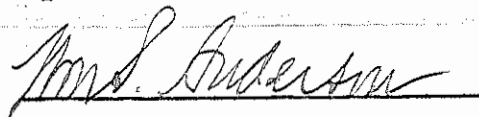

The Town of Bay Minette, by its Attorney, Wm. S. Anderson, charges that the offense of operating a motor vehicle upon the streets of the Town of Bay Minette, Alabama, at a greater rate of speed than twelve miles an hour, was committed by Foster Hayles, the defendant, within sixty days before the commencement of this prosecution, and in violation of Section 4 of An Ordinance, To provide for the regulation of Motor Vehicles operated upon the Streets of the Town of Bay Minette, adopted July 21st 1913, in words and figures as follows; "Section 4. No person shall operate a motor vehicle upon the streets of said town at a greater rate of speed than twelve miles an hour."
