COUNT TWO: Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars due from him by promissory note made by him on the 21st day of March, 1930, and payable the first day of August, 1930, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still due and unpaid.

COUNT THREE: Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars due from him by promissory note made by him on the 21st day of March, 1930, and payable the first day of September, 1930, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still due and unpaid.


COUNT FOUR: Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Hundred Nine and 87/100 (\$109.87) Dollars due from him by promissory note made by him on the 21st day of March, 1930,

and payable the first day of October, 1930, which sum of money with the interest thereon, is still due and unpaid.

COUNT FIVE: Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Hundred Nine and 87/100 (\$109.87) Dollars due from him by promissory note made by him on the 21st day of March, 1930, and payable the first day of November, 1930, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still due and unpaid.

COUNT SIX: Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Sixty-Nine and 88/100 (\$69.88) Dollars, balance due from him by promissory note made by him on the 21st day of March, 1930, and payable the first day of December, 1930, which sum of money, with the interest thereon, is still due and unpaid.

Plaintiff avers that in and by the terms of the notes hereinabove sued upon in Counts One, Two, Three, Four, Five and Six, the Defendant waived all right to claim personal property as exempt from execution and sale or other process issued for the collection of same, and agreed to pay all cost of collecting, securing or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorneys' fee, which Plaintiff claims, to-wit, Seventy-Five and 00/100 (\$75.00) Dollars.
