(1) The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), for that, on, to-wit, March 24th, 1952, the defendant negligently drove an authmobile into plaintiff's automobile at a point on the public highway leading from Bay Minette to Stapleton in Baldwin County, Alabama, one hundred fifty yards north of what is known as Long's Filling Station, and as a proximate result of said negligence on the part of the defendant, the plaintiff's automobile was wrecked, the front axle bent, the left hand front and rear fenders and running board bent and the frame hood and body bent and damaged; the plaintiff was bruised and caused to suffer great mental anguish, all to plaintiff's damage as aforesaid.

(2) The Plaintiff claims of the defendant the further sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) damages, for that, on, to-wit, the 24th day of March, 1932, plaintiff was driving his automobile along the public highway leading from Bay Minette to Stapleton in Baldwin County, Alabama, at a point about one hundred and fifty yards north of what is known as Long's Filling Station, and the plaintiff avers that the defendant wilfully and maliciously injured plaintiff and greatly damaged his automobile by causing the automobile in which defendant was driving to run into or against the plaintiff's automobile and as the proximate result of said wilfullness and maliciousness, plaintiff was braised and caused to suffer great physical pain and mental
