until sixty days after this date, and that if an appeal is taken within sixty days he shall not marry again except to

truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, the said witnesses,

doth depose and say as follows:

William Morris Resmondo, the complainant in this case, who testifies in his own behalf as follows:-

My name is William Morris Resmondo and I am the complainant in this case against my wife, Lottie Emma Resmondo. We are both over the age of twenty one years and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama and have been for more than three years next immediately preceding the filing of this complaint.

We have no children. We were married at Pensacola, Fla., December 19th., 1911 by Judge Henry Ballenger. We lived together as man and wife until on or about February 10th., 1924, when my wife drove me off and voluntarily deserted and abandoned me and has continuously since that time voluntarily abandoned and deserted me without just cause. We were living at Lillian, Alabama. She has refused to return and live with me. I have given her substantially all my property to take care of her. I am a carpenter by trade and am thirty-eight years of age. She is about 29 years old. She has continued to live separate and apart from me ever since she left me.

William Morris Resmondo

Mrs. Annie Mitchell, a material witness for the complainant, being duly sworn, testifies as follows:

My name is Mrs. Annie Mitchell and I am the wife of Henry Mitchell. I am over twenty one years of age and lived in this county all my life at Lillian, Alabama, in Baldwin County, Alabama. I know both William Morris Resmondo and Lottie Emma Resmondo. I remember when they were married but cannot recall the date. They are both over 21 years of age and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, where they have lived practically all their life and for more than three years before the filing of this bill.

Lottie Emma Resmondo quit and voluntarily abandoned William Morris Resmondo sometime in February, 1924 but I do not remember the exact date and she has continued to so voluntarily abandon him since that time. They have not lived together since. This took place in Baldwin County, Alabama. They have no children. Lottie Emma Resmondo now lives at Perdido Beach in Baldwin County, Alabama.

Mrs Annie Mitchell

Henry Mitchell, a material witness for complainant being duly sworn, testifies as follows:-

My name is Henry Mitchell and I am the husband of Mrs. Annie Mitchell, I know both William Morris Resmondo and Lottie Emma Resmondo. They are both over the age of twenty one years and were married sometime in December, 1911 and lived together as man and wife until about February, 1924, when the said Lottie Emma Resmondo left William Morris Resmondo and voluntarily abandoned him and has never since lived together with him as man and wife. They have no children. William Morris Resmondo and Lottie Emma Resmondo have lived in Baldwin County, Alabama all their life and still live in Baldwin County, Alabama, William Morris Resmondo going to and from his work in Mobile County.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS AND RELIEF.

THE PREMISES CONSIDERED, Complainant prays that all necessary orders and notices be issued necessary to make the said Lottie Emma Resmondo party respondent to this cause and that upon a final hearing hereof your Honor will render, adjudge and decree that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between your complainant and the defendant be forever dissolved and that your complainant be again permitted to contract the marriage relation should he so desire, and, as in duty bound he will ever pray, etc.
