Wew were living at Lillian, Alabama. She has refused to return and live with me. I have given her substantially all my property to take care of her. I am a carpenter by trade and am thirty-eight years of age. She is about 29 years old. She has continued to live separate and apart from me ever since she left me.

Mrs. Annie Mitchell, a material witness for the complainant, being duly sworn, testifies as follows:

My name is Mrs. Annie Mitchell and I am the wife of Henry Mitchell. I am over twenty one years of age and lived in this county all my life at Lillian, Alabama, in Baldwin County, Alabama. I know both William Morris Resmondo and Lottie Emma Resmondo. I rember when they were married but cannot recall the date. They are both over 21 years of age and are residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, where they have lived practically all their life and for more than three years before the filing of this bill.

Lottie Emma Resmondo quit and voluntarily abandoned William Morris Resmondo sometime in February, 1924 but I do not remember the exact date and she has continued to so voluntary abandon him since that time. They have not lived to-gether since. This took place in Baldwin County, Alabama. They have no children. Lottie Emma Resmondo now lives at Perdido Beach in Baldwin County, Alabama.


