COUNT ONE:

Highway 98 at a point approximately one mile north of Daphne, Baldwin County, Alabama, where he had a right to be and while said automobile was being operated and driven by the Plaintiff, the Defendant, Eva Backburn Pitts, negligently caused or allowed an automobile which she was then and there operating, to run upon, over or against the automobile of the Plaintiff, causing great damages and injuries to the Plaintiff's automobile: the top, front axle, left front wheel, front bumper, left front fender and other parts of the Plaintiff's automobile were broken, bent, smashed or otherwise damaged and injured, all to the damage of the Plaintiff as aforesaid. The Plaintiff avers that by reason of said injuries and damages he lost the use of said automobile and was compelled
