According to my records, the Plaintiff is entitled to judgement by default in each of the above cases.

In the case of Mr. Campbell, the judgement should be for \$839.45 principal, \$150.00 Attorney fee, \$208.86 interest; a total of \$1198.31. The foundation note is herewith enclosed.

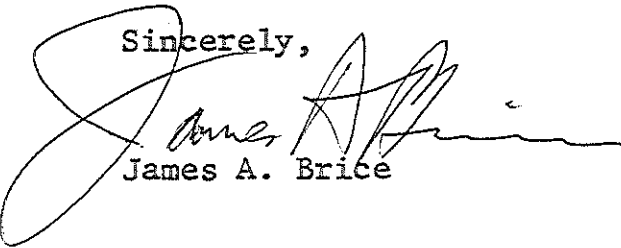

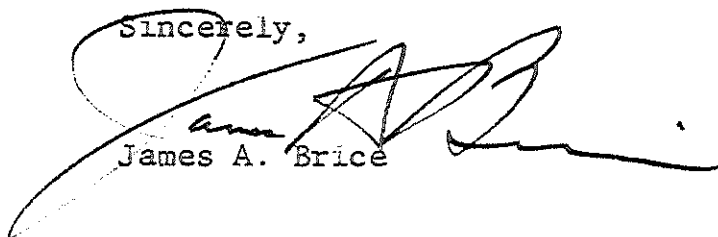
Dear Mrs. Duck:
