Comes now Thomas Ausphera Hall and shows unto the Court as follows:

1.

That on the 21st day of December, 1960, the Director of the Department of Public Safety of the State of Alabama, issued an order, to become effective January 12, 1961, suspending the drivers license and registration plates of the Appellant. Your Appellant now comes and makes this his appeal to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, the place of his residence, as is provided for in the 1940 Code of Alabama, Title 36, Section 74 (43).

The Defendant avers further that this revocation is based on the following facts and circumstances:

That on or about November 4, 1960, the Appellant was driving his automobile along a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, and that he was driving in accordance with the "rules of the roads". That Lee "Buckshot" Catrett, who was driving an automobile in the

same direction as the Appellant, ran into a post or barrier on the left side of the road and swerved back across the road into the side and rear of the Appellant's automobile. The Appellant avers further that Lee "Buckshot" Catrett was wholly at fault in causing this accident.

Your Appellant says that as a result of this accident, the Department of Public Safety sent him a notice which reads, in part, as follows:

As a result of the above referred to motor vehicle accident in which you or a motor vehicle owned by you were involved, you have become subject to the Alabama Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Law.

(1) If there was in effect at the time of the accident a standard provisions automobile liability policy insuring your liability for damages resulting from the accident, you must secure at once from the insurance agent or company a notice to that effect, (Form SR 21), and send it to this Unit with this letter. If you file Form SR 21 you are relieved of furnishing security, and you should disregard the remainder of this letter.

(2) If you are unable to comply with paragraph (1) above, then you are required on or before the effective date of the below order of suspension.

(a) To deposit cash, certified check, surety bond or negotiable securities in the amount of \$409.00 with the Department of Public Safety, Safety Responsibility Unit, as security to satisfy any judgment or judgments for damages resulting from the accident.

(b) Or to submit to the Department of Public Safety, Safety Responsibility Unit, a notarized release for damages from all persons injured, whether a pedestrian, an occupant of your vehicle or any other vehicle involved in the accident, and from all persons whose property was damaged in excess of fifty dollars (\$50.00), which may be a general release or a conditional release based on an agreement to pay an agreed amount in installments.

Order of Suspension

In the event of your failure to comply with the provisions of law, YOU ARE ORDERED to forward to the Department of Public Safety, Safety Responsibility Unit, on or before the effective date of this order, the following numbered license, registration certificate and plate, and all other licenses, registration certificates and plates issued in your name.

The herein suspension is ordered in accordance with the provisions of 1951 Alabama Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act 704, Section 5, Sub-section (b).

The Appellant says that he could not furnish the Department with a Form SR 21, is unwilling to deposit \$409.00 with the Department of Public Safety and has not yet been able to obtain release from Lee "Buckshot" Catrett.

The Defendant respectfully requests the Court to stay the order of the said Director pending an outcome of this appeal.

This day came Thomas Ausphera Hall and files the foregoing verified petition in this Court and upon consideration of the same, the Court is of the opinion that he is entitled to a Stay of suspension order made by the Director of the Department of Public Safety in this cause. It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the suspension order issued by the Director of Public Safety revoking Thomas Ausphera Hall's driving licenses and registration plates be, and is, hereby stayed pending a Final Hearing of this cause.
