COUNT ONE:

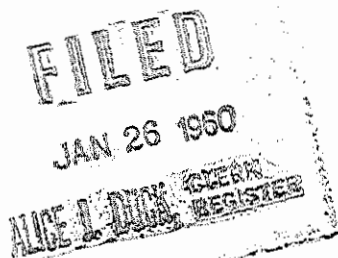
