AGREEMENT AND PETITION FOR LUMP SUM SETTLEMENT UNDER WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION LAW

The undersigned Neal Harville, the petitioner (employee),
Ray E. Loper Lumber Company, Inc., d/b/a Loper Hauling Company,
defendant (employer), and the American Employers' Insurance Company,
the defendant employer's insurance carrier, being the only parties
interested in this proceeding, hereby petition the Court for approval of the following agreement and settlement of this proceeding and
agree and represent to this Court as follows:

- 1. The said employer and the said employee are now and were on the date of the accident hereinafter referred to subject to the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law of Alabama. The said employee, fifty-one years of age, residing in Baldwin County, Alabama, who can read and understand the English language, did on, to-wit, the 17th day of July, 1958, sustain an injury by accident while employed by the said employer, which accident and injury arose out of his employment and occurred in Escambia County, Alabama, which resulted in a twenty-six percent (26%) permanent partial disability of the said employee, who was receiving at the time of the said injury wages at the rate of \$39.72 per week.
- 2. The defendant employer, through its said insurance carrier, has, prior to the filing of this petition, paid to the said employee compensation for fifty-two (52) weeks at the rate of \$23.83 per week, making a total of Twelve Hundred Thirty-nine and 16/100 Dollars (\$1239.16).
- 3. The employee acknowledges that he has received the full medical, surgical and hospital benefits provided by the Work-men's Compensation Law, the cost of all of which has been paid by the defendant employer's said insurance carrier.

- 4. It is hereby agreed that the said employee is entitled to and shall receive additional compensation for the said injury in the amount of Eighteen Hundred Eighty-six and 55/100 Dollars (\$1886.55), to be paid in a lump sum, together with the costs of this proceeding, making a total of Thirty-one Hundred Twenty-five and 71/100 Dollars (\$3125.71).
- 5. The employer shall also pay the court costs incurred in this proceeding.
- 6. Upon payment of the said balance of \$1886.55 and the costs of this proceeding, amounting to \$16.00, the said employer and its said insurance carrier shall be and they are each relieved of and discharged from all other and further liability of every kind and nature to the said employee.

- 1. The Plaintiff, Neal Harville, is a resident citizen of Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, and is over the age of twenty-one years. The Defendant, Ray E. Loper Lumber Company, Inc., a corporation, doing business as Loper Hauling Company, is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Alabama, with its principal place of business in Bay Minette, Alabama.
- 2. On July 17, 1958, the Plaintiff, while employed by Ray E. Loper Lumber Company, Inc., a corporation, doing business as Loper Hauling Company, suffered injuries proximately resulting from an accident arising out of and in the course of his employment as a servant or employee of the Defendant as follows: that he was riding in the cab of a truck of the Defendant on U. S. Highway 31, about five miles East of Wabeek Community in Escambia County, Alabama, while engaged in delivering dressed lumber of the Defendant and said truck turned

over and caused the fracture of the sixth and seventh cervical vertebra and the first thoracic vertebra of the Plaintiff. That as a proximate result of said injuries the Plaintiff was rendered permanently disabled to the extent of forty to fifty (40% to 50%) percent.

- 3. That subsequent to the receipt of said injuries by the Plaintiff Ray E. Loper Lumber Company, Inc., a corporation, doing business as Loper Hauling Company, through their insurance carrier, paid the Plaintiff compensation in the total amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-nine Dollars and Sixteen Cents (\$1,239.16) but discontinued such compensation payments on, to-wit: July 27, 1959. Said compensation was paid every two weeks at the rate of Forty-seven Dollars and Sixty-six Cents (\$47.66) per week.
