

COUNT II

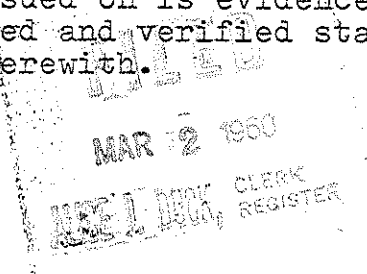
