The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100ths (\$750.00) DOLLARS as damages, for that, heretofore, on, to-wit: the 10th day of November, 1959, at about 6:00 o'clock, A. 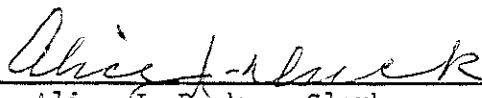
