TO THE HONORABLE HUBERT M. HALL, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN
COUNTY, ALABAMA:

Comes now your Petitioner, Clifford McLain, and shows unto the
Court:

1.

That he is over the age of 21 years, a resident citizen of Baldwin
County, Alabama; that he is the father of Linda Ann McLain; that Linda
Ann McLain has lived with him and his wife all of her life; that Linda
Ann McLain is now about 4 monts of age.

2.

That Louise V. McLain, who is the mother of Linda Ann McLain, has
taken Linda Ann McLain out of Baldwin County and into another state and
there unlawfully restrained her.

3.

Your Petitioner has reasonable cause for believing and does verily
believe that Louise V. McLain will again take Linda Ann McLain out of
the State of Alabama and beyond the jurisdiction of this court unless
this writ of Habeas Corpus is granted and your petitioner will be put
to great trouble and expense in regaining her custody.

4.

Your Petitioner has filed a cause of action in Baldwin County, Alabama
for a divorce from Louise V. McLain and to determine the permanent care,
custody and control of Linda Ann McLain. That on May 16 your Honor signed
a decree granting temporary custody of Linda Ann McLain to your petitioner
pending the outcome of the aforementioned cause and Louise V. McLain has
refused to recongize the Court's decree, Therefore your Petitioner respect-
fully prays that this court will issue this injunction and cause Linda Ann
McLain to be kept in Baldwin County and in the Petitioner's custody, care
and control until this issue is settled.

Your Petitioner prays that this writ of habeas corpus be issued and directed to the said Louise V. McLain commanding her to bring the body of Linda Ann McLain before Your Honor at such time and place as may be appointed by you together with the cause of the Petitioner's detention.

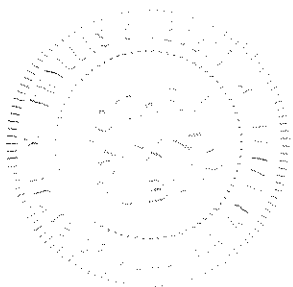

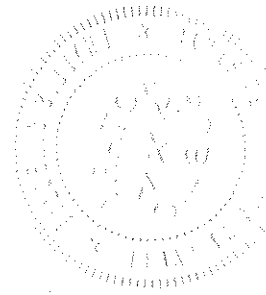
