The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That whereas the above bounden *J. P. Leake* on the *15th* day of *May* 1917 *D. C. Byrne* a Justice of the Peace in and for *Baldwin County* and State at the suit of *J. P. Leake* against *Crosted & Shollar* did render Judgment in favor of *Crosted & Shollar* has this day applied for, and obtained an appeal, returnable to the *Spring* Term, *1881* of the *Circuit* *Baldwin County* *Supreme Court* of Alabama, to supersede and reverse a Judgment recovered by the said *D. C. Byrne* Justice of the Peace

against the said *J. P. Leake* on the *15th* day of *May* 1917

at the *Term*, *1881* of the *Circuit Court* of *Baldwin*, for *Baldwin* County, for *Twenty* Dollars, besides costs.
