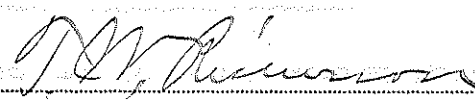

Personally appeared before me, Watts K. Leverich, Commissioner appointed to take the deposition of D. E. Hendricks, a material witness for the plaintiff in the above entitled cause, D. E. Hendricks, who being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, deposes and says:
To Interrogatory one he says:

I am Credit Man for Swift & Co., Harvey, and have been there about nine years.

To Interrogatory two he says:

Yes, Swift & Co, did have dealings with the defendants in this suit. Baldwin Bros. acted as our agents for several years for the sale of fertilizer at Summerdale, Ala. They operated on a consignment contract which provided that they render us immediate accounting covering all their sales, whether made on time or for cash.

To Interrogatory three he says:

Yes, Swift & Co. delivered goods, wares and merchandise to said defendants deliveries of same being through the years 1913-4-5.

To Interrogatory four he says:

The contract that operated between Baldwin Bros. and Swift & Co. was a consignment one, providing that when Baldwin Bros. made a sale to a farmer of fertilizer, that this sale was to be closed up with the farmer immediately by a note, if the sale was on time, or cash, if the sale was on a cash basis, and then prompt accounting was to be rendered Swift & Co. for any and all sales, and deliveries. were made to Baldwin Bros., and the partners of that firm, only on the basis of the contract as stated above.

To insure the faithful performance of their part of the contract, we required Baldwin Bros. to give a surety bond, the National Surety Co. being the insurer.

To Interrogatory five he says:

This contract of agency between Baldwin Bros. and Swift & Co. was in writing. I have not the original and therefore cannot annex same to these depositions; it is not now in the possession of Swift & Co. nor under its control. This contract was sent to our attorneys, Messrs. McMillan & Grayson of Mobile, who were representing us in the bankruptcy proceedings of Baldwin Bros., and it was our impression that the same would be filed in the bankruptcy proceedings. I inquired of our attorneys, Messrs. McMillan & Grayson, about this contract, and was advised that it was their impression also that the contract had been filed in the bankruptcy proceeding, but that the Referee, before whom the proceedings were held, was not able to locate same.

It is equally impossible for me to file a copy of this contract for the reason that we kept none in our file, and as I have not the original, I cannot make a copy thereof. I have stated above in an answer to a prior interrogatory in detail the terms of the contract under which deliveries of said goods, merchandise and wares were made, and the goods, wares and merchandise delivered to them under the above mentioned contract were valued at \$15,137.15.

To Interrogatory five (part 2) he says:

The goods so delivered to Baldwin Bros., at Summerdale, Ala., were not paid for, except to the extent of \$13,829.46, which amount was credited to their account from time to time, leaving a balance due by the said Baldwin Bros., of \$1,307.67.

Swift & Co. did transfer, assign and deliver their claim against Baldwin Bros. for the amount due, to the plaintiff in this suit, to-wit the National Surety Company. This assignment was made in writing by Swift & Company on June 16, 1917, and was acknowledged on the same day before E.K. Kixmiller, a Notary Public for Cook County, Ill.
