Two hundred seventeen and 80/100 Dollars, with interest thereon from the 19th day of Nov 1918, to day of



Whereas, at the Fall Term 1917 of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, to-wit: on the 19th day of November, 1917, being a regular day of said term, the First National Bank, a corporation, recovered a judgment against W.A.Tunstall for the sum of Two hundred and seventeen & 80/100 Dollars and costs of suit, and affidavit having been made by Charles Hall, as attorney for said corporation, that James A.Carney is supposed to be indebted to or have effects of said W.A.Tunstall in his possession, or under his control; and that he believes process of garnishment against said James A.Carney is necessary to obtain satisfaction of said judgment.

You are therefore hereby commanded to summon the said James A.Carney to be and appear before the Honorable, the Circuit Court for Baldwin County, at the Court House thereof on the 20th, day of May, 1918, then and there within the three first days of the term to answer on oath whether at the time of the service of the garnishment, or at the time of making his answer, or at any time intervening between the time of serving the garnishment and making the answer, he was indebted to the defendant, W.A.Tunstall, and whether he will not be indebted in the future to him by a contract then existing and whether by a contract then existing, he is liable to him for the delivery of personal property, or for the payment of money which may be discharged by the delivery of personal property, or which is payable in personal property, and whether he has not in his possession or under his control money or effects belonging to the said W.A.Tunstall, defendant.
