The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred Forty-Nine and 71/100 (\$149.71) Dollars due by promissory note made by him on the 10th day of May, 1915, and payable on the 15th day of November, 1915, with interest due thereon.

2. The plaintiff claims of the defendant the sum of One Hundred-Forty-Nine and 71/100 (\$149.71) Dollard due by promissory note, ~~xxxxx~~ made by him on the 10th day of May, 1915, and payable on the 1st day of November, 1915, with interest due thereon from date.

3. The plaintiff further claims of the defendant the sum of Fifty-five (\$55.00) as a reasonable attorneys fee for filing this suit as provided in and by said promissory note; the plaintiff further alleges that in and by said instrument the defendant waived all right to the claim of personal property exempt him under the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, which he claims the benefit thereof.


