

The answers of Fred . C Hall one of the defendants to the interrogatories propounded by Plaintiff.

To the first Interrogatory he saith:-

I was engaged in the business of buying and selling produce during the months of April and May 1917 at Bay Minette, Ala, as Secretary and Manager of Farmers Trucking and Live Stock Association, as agent for its members.

To the 2nd. Intg. he saith.

The Farmers Trucking and Live Stock Association was not a corporation or a partnership but simply an association of Farmers and Truckers.

To the 3rd. Intg. he saith:-

I was elected at a regular meeting of the Farmers Trucking and Live Stock Association held in Jury room of Baldwin County Court House on Jan. 27th. 1917.

To the 4th. Intg. he saith:-

The other officers elected for the year 1917 were D D Jayne. President. Herman Boescher Vice President. W D Stapleton. Treasurer.

To the 5th. Intg. he saith.

I had business relations with such officers and members of the Association during the months of April and May 1917 and sold produce for the following members and officers. D D Jayne. Pres. Herman Boescher. Vice. Pres. W H Byrne. R D Byrne. H I West. D W Merwin. D F Aylin. Max Kleiger. G A Merrill. E B Johnson. F J Arnould. W R Gibson. John M Green. G R Holton. W L Booker. A B Coddington. A F Mc Callum. B G Taylor. J R Williams. Sarah Munn and J F Akers.

I rendered bills and statements on Stationary of Farmerstncking and Live Stock Association.

To the 6th. Intg. he saith.

Yes I sold and handled on commission basis for John M Green during the months of April and May 1917 produce, I acted as his agent in selling these goods, his potatoes were delivered on loading platform of the L & N R R at Bay Minette, Ala. and were received by Ted Mc Millan and Fred C Hall. Mc Millan was working for me.

To the seventh Intg. he saith:-

These potatoes of John M G

These potatoes of John M Greens were delivered in 7/8th. and 1 bushel hampers, I did not count the hampers or loads as they were weighed when sacked, and all of John M Greens potatoes delivered were carefully weighed that were delivered to me. They were shipped in sacks and the rule was to weigh them when sacked no matter in what package they were brought in. All of Greens potatoes were correctly weighed and he was given all just credit for full weight of his potatoes.

To the 8th. Intg. he saith:-

John M Greens potatoes were received, handled and sold by me as the agent of John M Green who was a member of the Farmers Trucking and Live Stock Association. together with myself.

To the 9th. Intg. he saith:-

John M Greens potatoes were weighed by Ted Mc Millan and F C Hall.

To the 11th. Intg. he saith:-

John M Greens potatoes were sold by me as the agent of John M Green one of the members of the Farmers Trucking and Live Stock Association for cash, to Sansome & Kline of Columbus Ohio, I was on commission basis and received my commission from the parties for whom I sold, I got 5% for handling, such as weighing, loading and sacking and selling. The sacks were furnished by the Association of which John M Green was a member and the price of same was paid by each shipper for the sacks he used.

To the 12th. Intg. he saith.

I have paid John M Green in full for every pound of potatoes he delivered to me to sell for him, he was given credit for every pound of potatoes he delivered and has been paid by me every cent due him, I paid John M Green by check on May 24th. 1917 the sum of \$161.75 and I also paid John M Green the further sum of \$562.26 by check dated May 26th.

1917. this was in full payment for proceeds in full for all potatoes delivered to me by John M Green, I have the cancelled checks in my possession.

The answer of Framers Trucking and live stock Association by D D Jayne its principal officer and President.

To the First Intg. he saith.

The Farmers Trucking and Live Stock Association was not a corporation or a partnership in April and May 1917, it was a voluntary association or club of Truckers and Farmers formed for mutual benefit so as to ship together in car lots. The Officers of the Association were as follows. D D Jayne. Pres. Herman Boeschen Vice. Pres. Fred C Hall Sec. & Mngr. and the members of the association were W H Byrne; R D Byrne. H I West. D W Merwin. D F Albin. G A Merrill. E B Johnson. F J Arnould. W R Gibson. John M Green. G R Holton. W L Booker. A B Coddington. A F Mc Callum. B G Taylor. J R Williams. Sarah Munn. J F Akers.

To the 2nd. Intg he saith.

Fred C Hall was secretary and business manager in April and May 1917 and bought, handled and sold produce on a commission basis individually for members of the Association, he acting as agent for each member.

To the 3rd. Intg. he saith.

The officers and members did not know of his dealings with others only for each individual one for whom he sold.

To the 4th. Intg. he saith. He was not acting in behalf of the Association but for himself individually and as the agent of each member who brought him produce. He received a commission not the Association.

The Association ~~xxxx~~ did no acts to prevent his selling and dealing in produce for them as an Association for he did not do so, only acted as the agent for any member who sought his services, JOHN M GREEN was as much a member of the Association as any of the others and knew that Fred C Hall was to get a commission for his services to the members for handling produce. In company with W H Byrne, and Herman Boeschen we examined the books and accounts of Fred C Hall and the weights allowed by him to John M Green and found that J

John M Green had been given credit for the proper number of hampers claimed by him and that the average weight per hamper was more than either Boeschen or myself had received.
