Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty dollars lawful money of the United States of America to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part at or before the ensealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the Said party of the second part his heirs executors and administrators forever released and discharged from the same by these presents has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, enfeoffed, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents does grant bargain sell alien remise release enfeoff convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that certain lot peice or parcel of land lying and being in the city of Mobile and described as follows, to-wit situated on the west side of Royal Street containing a front of forty four feet thereon and a depth of one hundred and forty four feet in extent therefrom bounded on the South by a lot belonging to Mr Miguel Esclava on the northward by a lot this day conveyed to the said J.Y. Cruzat by Claire Durett^c and Orestedelande her husband on the eastward by Royal Street and on the westward by a line parallel to said Royal Street at the distance of one hundred and forty four feet therefrom together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments rights members privilege and appurtenances unto the above mentioned and described premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the above granted and described premises with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns to the sole and proper use benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
