


MOTION TO DISMISS

COMPLAINT


The plaintiff claims of the defendant TWELVE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SIX and No/100 DOLLARS (\$12,106.00) , due by promissory note made by him on the 30th day of April, 1954, and payable on the 30th day of April, 1955, with interest thereon from April 30, 1954, at six percent per annum.

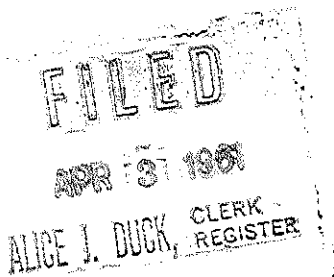
And plaintiff admits credits on said note as follows:
 \$85.00 on September 10, 1954; \$625.71 on October 16, 1954;
 \$4,017.63 on October 22, 1954; \$63.63 on November 4, 1954;
 \$610.00 on December 30, 1954; \$20.00 on October 4, 1955;

\$20.00 on November 9, 1955; \$20.00 on December 12, 1955;
\$20.00 on January 26, 1956; \$20.00 on February 20, 1956;
\$20.00 on March 26, 1956; \$20.00 on May 9, 1956; \$20.00
on June 9, 1956; \$20.00 on July 10, 1956; \$20.00 on
August 13, 1956; \$20.00 on September 11, 1956; and \$20.00
on April 24, 1957.

And the plaintiff claims of the defendant the further and
additional sum of NINE HUNDRED FORTY and No/100 DOLLARS (\$940.00),
as a reasonable attorney's fee, which the defendant agreed to pay
by a written provision in said note.

And the plaintiff avers that so far as this debt is concerned
the defendant waived all right to have exempted to him any personal
property which is now or may hereafter be exempted to him under
the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama.






Dear Mrs. Duck:
