Peturis, then and there so negligently operated a motor vehicle so that it collided with or against the motorcycle on which Plaintiff was riding and as a proximate result and consequence of the negligence of the Defendant, Plaintiff was injured in this, to-wit: Plaintiff received compound dislocations of the second, third and fourth m.p. joints of his right hand; his face was deeply cut and lacerated; his right knee was severely sprained; there were abrasions on Plaintiff's left hand; these injuries caused a cast to be put on Plaintiff's right hand and arm, his face sutured, his right hand to become stiff, painful and sore, his right knee to suffer acute flexion and severe pain, a tender groove to be in the dorsum of Plaintiff's right forearm resulting from severe contusions and Plaintiff is unable to completely bend his right knee; there is contraction of the palmar fascia of Plaintiff's right hand; Plaintiff was caused to suffer severe pain and agony, to be permanently disabled and permanently restricted in his normal activity; he was caused to lose time from his work; he will be caused to lose time from his work in the future; he will be disabled in the future; he will be permanently less able to enjoy recreation; he was caused to incur doctor bills, hospital bills and other medical bills due to his injuries; he will be caused to be less able to earn a livelihood in the future; he will be permanently abnormal; he will be permanently less able to participate in recreational activities; Plaintiff was caused to be sick, sore and lame and to suffer great mental anguish, hence this suit.
