COUNT ONE



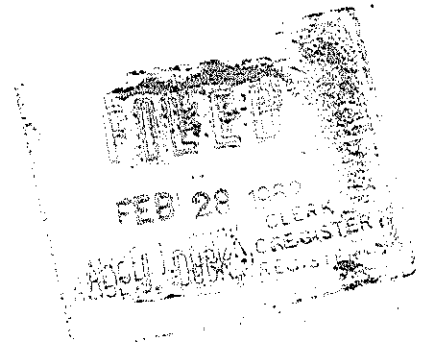
COUNT THREE
