
COUNT ONE:

Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of TWO HUNDRED FOURTEEN and 90/100 (\$214.90) DOLLARS, due by Promissory Note made by him on the 12th day of July, 1957 and payable in monthly installments of THIRTY NINE and 79/100 (\$39.79) DOLLARS each, the 1st installment being due on the 24th day of August, 1957, with interest thereon.

That in and by the terms of the said note, the Defendant promised that if any one of said installments or any portion thereof should become due and remain unpaid, then all the remaining unpaid installments should be due and payable at once and Plaintiff further avers that the defendant has defaulted and now declares the entire balance due and payable.
