PLEA:

Comes now the Defendant in the above styled cause and for answer to the Complaint heretofore filed in said cause pleads separately and severally as follows:

1. Not guilty.

2. That the Plaintiff was guilty of negligence at the time and place complained of in his complaint which proximately contributed to his alleged damages in that the Plaintiff so negligently operated his motor vehicle as to cause or allow the same to run into, upon or against the automobile which was then and there being driven by the Defendant, A. B. McDill, hence he should not recover.

3. For further plea and by way of recoupment the Defendant, A. B. McDill claims of the Plaintiff the sum of \$500.00 as damages for that heretofore, on to-wit: December 19, 1961, at a point between 14th and 15th streets on Hand Avenue in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama, the Plaintiff so negligently operated a motor vehicle as to cause or allow the same to run into, upon or against a motor vehicle driven by the Defendant, A. B. McDill, and as a proximate result of such negligence the automobile of the Defendant was damaged in this: the left front fender was bent, damaged and broken; the left side was bent, damaged and broken; the left front headlamp was bent, damaged and broken; the left front bumper was bent, damaged and broken; the front wheels were knocked out of line, all to the damage of the Defendant in the above sum.


COUNT ONE
